We plan a safe, sustainable and successful alpine style climbing expedition to a remote part of North East Greenland. We plan to climb 3 unclimbed peaks in the area and establish new routes up 4 previously climbed peaks.

The expedition will remove all waste from the two planned base camps providing a low impact.

Scheduled flight Glasgow to Keflavik, then to Constable Point or Mestersvig in north East Greenland. Transfer by helicopter or ski equipped plane (Norlandair) to the Sefstroms Glacier in the Staunings Alps N71°58'0.0" W025° 08.5'.

Camping on the glacier. Attempt at the highest unclimbed peak in the Staunings Alps (one attempt repulsed in 1998), technical routes on major peaks in the area; South face of Sussex (one attempt repulsed in 2003); Western outlier of Hekla.

Climbing in the Sefstroms area for 7 days then a 2 day ski traverse across the Col de Pulkas and Crescent Col to the Gully Glacier N72°05'27.4" W024° 58'42.8".

Bolvaerket by East face, and western outlier; Am Caisteal west face; Korsspids by east face and north ridge.

Climbing in this area for 7 days then collection by helicopter or ski equipped plane back to Mestersvig or Constable Point.

Return flight to Iceland then the UK.
