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Youth Climbing Series Changes to the Regulations for 2010

This advice must be read in conjunction with the current Youth Climbing Series Regulations for 2010:

1.1.3 *“The National Governing Body (NGB) may allow variations of the three-round structure to accommodate regional finals or other events.”*
This permits changes to the format such as the Wales Final.

1.2.6 *“Members of the British Competition Climbing Team are not allowed to enter Youth Climbing Series.”*

2.13.2 The following new clause refers to the British Final team competition:
*“Where competitors are tied in a category, each will be awarded the average of ranking points shared by the tied group.
Example 1: If three competitors are tied in third place they are ‘occupying’ third, fourth and fifth places which would be a total of $65+55+51=171$ ranking points so each competitor would be awarded $171\div 3=57$ points.
Example 2: If two competitors are tied in second place they would each be awarded $(80+65)\div 2=72.5$ points.”*

REMOVED THE FOLLOWING REGULATION (CLAUSE 3.6.3 IN 2009) HAS BEEN REMOVED:

“Only such parts of an object which are usable for climbing shall be considered when determining the score of a competitor.”
