This includes fully rigid winter mountaineering boots, gaiters, crampons, ice axe, full waterproofs, hat, goggles and gloves. There are **NO** facilities at Nevis Range to hire this equipment. If a student arrives ill-prepared for winter conditions, they will not be allowed on the course.
