Natural protection Placements



1 Wide slots

These slots will accept large nuts. Hexes, camming devices may also be used.

2 Nut placements

These cracks will accept a variety of medium to small sizes of nuts / stoppers. etc

Try to use the biggest nut possible to fit the crack.
Set your nut well
Use of extenders will minimise the risk of placements lifting out



3 Spikes

Short Tape sling required.
An extra turn around the spike, will avoid it being lifted off.

4 Threads

Short Tape sling required.
Always clip both ends of sling. larks foot is not recommended

First time leaders are advised to use two ropes, One rope for the traditional gear placements and One rope for insitu runners on a Neighbouring sport route.
